ORDINANCE # 405

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES AND
OFF-ROAD VEHICLES OPERATION IN THE CITY OF EDNA,
KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY
OF EDNA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. No all-terrain vehicles or off-road vehicles may be operated within the City of Edna, except a person may operate such a vehicle on real property owned by the person or upon private real property with the written permission of the owner of said real property. An off-road vehicle will include, but not limit to, go-carts, dirt bikes, mini-bikes, all-terrain vehicles, dune buggies, motorized bicycles, midget vehicles and any other motorized vehicle not required by law to have a license plate. This Ordinance does not pertain to farm tractors or farm implements when used for agricultural purposes. City employees are exempt when performing city duties.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly drive or operate any all-terrain or off-road vehicle, or the owner of any all-terrain or off-road vehicle to knowingly allow or permit any other person to drive or operate such vehicles upon any public street, alley, highway or any other city property. The all-terrain or off-road vehicle may be impounded.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance excludes any person in a wheelchair of any kind, any person requiring a personal assistive mobility device and riding mowers used for purpose of lawn service. Manual operated recreational items such as but not limited to, scooters, roller skates, rollerblades and skateboards are prohibited on or from crossing any state highway.

SECTION 4. Violation of this Ordinance is a misdemeanor punishable upon conviction of a fine not to exceed \$500.00.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon publication in the Edna Sun, official city newspaper.
