

ORDINANCE NO. 424

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO CONNECTION OF WATER METERS IN THE CITY OF EDNA, KANSAS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 399.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF EDNA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. There shall be a one hundred twenty-five dollar (\$125.00) connection fee for every customer having or requesting metered water service from the city. Connection charges may be waived for a customer wishing to transfer service from one location in the city to another within the city provided the transfer occurs within 60 days of the termination of service of the first property or location. No waiver shall occur under this section if the customer is or has been delinquent within the last 365 days.

SECTION 2. For customers who are current and request a temporary shut-off for vacation on their water meters, there shall be a ten dollar (\$10.00) reconnect charge. Temporary shall be defined for the purpose of this ordinance as a period of not to exceed 180 days.


SECTION 3. For customers who have their water meters locked or pulled due to delinquent payment, there will be a thirty-five dollar (\$35.00) reconnect charge to be paid at the time that the account is brought current. For reconnects performed on weekends, holidays or after the regular work hours there shall be an additional thirty dollar (\$30.00) charge to be paid in advance. Any such reconnect shall be solely upon availability of personnel.

SECTION 4. All charges are non-refundable.


SECTION 5. Ordinances 310, 325, 377, 378 and 399 are hereby repealed and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the forgoing are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official newspaper.
