ORDINANCE NO. 482

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE OPERATIONS OF WORK-SITE UTILITY VEHICLES, GOLF CARTS AND OTHER SMALL VEHICLES ON THE STREETS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF EDNA, KANSAS; PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS, INCLUDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF; AND, PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF SECTION 114.2, 114.4 AND 114.5 OF THE 2016 STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF EDNA, AS ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 479.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF EDNA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

Small vehicles shall include all of the following vehicles listed within this subsection as follows;

Work-site vehicle: means any motor vehicle which is not less than 48 inches in width, has an overall length, including the bumper, of not more than 160 inches, has an un-laden weight, including fuel and fluids, of not more than 800 pounds and in equipped with 4 or more low-pressure tires, a steering wheel and a bench or bucket-type seat allowing at least two people to sit side-by-side, and factory equipped with a bed or cargo box for hauling materials.

Micro Utility Truck: means any motor vehicle which is not less than 48 inches in width, has an overall length, including bumper, of not more than 144 inches, has an un-laden weight, including fuel and fluids, of 1500 pounds, can exceed 40 miles per hour as originally manufactured and is manufactured with a metal cab.

Golf Cart: means a motor vehicle that has not less than three wheels in contact with the ground, an un-laden weight of not more than 1,800 pounds, is designed to be operated at not more than 25 miles per hour and is designed to carry no less than two and not more than four persons, including the driver.

SECTION 2. OPERATIONS OF SMALL VEHICLES.

(a) All vehicles described in Section 1 may be operated upon the public highways, streets, roads and alleys within the corporate limits of the city; provided, however, that no Small Vehicle may be operated upon any public highway, street, road and alley with a posted speed limit in excess of 45 miles per hour. No Small Vehicle shall be operated on any interstate highway, federal highway or state highway outside the city limits; provided, however, that the provisions of this subsection shall not prohibit a Small Vehicle from crossing a federal or state highway or a street or highway with a posted speed limit greater than 45 miles per hour.

(b) Small Vehicles must be equipped with turn signals, rear view mirror, headlights, taillights, brake lights, horn and a standard OEM type muffler.

(c) Every person operating a Small Vehicle on the public highways, streets, roads and alleys of the city shall be subject to all of the duties applicable to a driver of a vehicle imposed by law.

SECTION 3. SAME: VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE REQUIRED; PENALTY.

No person shall operate a Small Vehicle on any public highway, street, road or alley within the corporate limits of the city unless such person has a valid driver's license. Violation of this section is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4. SAME: PENALTY.

Unless specifically provided herein, a violation of this section shall be deemed an ordinance traffic infraction. Upon an entry of a plea of guilty or no contest or upon being convicted of such violation, the penalty imposed shall be in accordance with Section 201, 2016 Standard Traffic Ordinance, and amendments thereto, or such other similar provision as the city may then have in effect.

SECTION 5. REPEALER.

Section 114.2, 114.4 and 114.5 of the 2016 Standard Traffic Ordinance of the Code of the City of Edna, as adopted by Ordinance No. 479 and any other ordinance in conflict, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. PUBLICATION; EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall be published one time in the official city newspaper, Labette Avenue, and shall take effect and be in force from and after said publication.
