## **ORDINANCE NO. 484**

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A CITY RETAILERS' SALES TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF AN ADDITIONAL ONE PERCENT (1%) WITHIN THE CITY OF EDNA, KANSAS, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2017.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF EDNA, KANSAS:

**SECTION 1.** A majority of the electors voting thereon having approved, at a special question election held on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2016, the levying of a retailers' sales tax in the City of Edna, for the purpose of improving and maintaining the city's infrastructures, public streets, sidewalks, parks and recreational facilities, as authorized by K.S.A. 12-187 *et seq.*, and amendments thereto, there is hereby levied a city retailers' sales tax in the amount of an additional one percent (1%) to take effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 2017 and end 10 years after the date of its first collection.

SECTION 2. Except as otherwise be provided by law, such tax shall be identical in its application and exemptions therefrom to the Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax Act and all laws and administrative rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Revenue relating to the state retailers' sales tax shall apply to such city retailers' sales tax insofar as such laws and regulations may be made applicable. The services of the Kansas Department of Revenue shall be utilized to administer, enforce and collect such tax.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be published one time in the official city newspaper, and a copy dully certified and submitted to the state director of taxation.
